Services for Mrs. Alicia (Aly) Winberg Hill are as follows:

Aly Winberg Hill, age 87, a native of Panama, Republic of Panama, and longtime resident of Lake Forest in Daphne, Alabama passed away Monday July 5, 2021.

Born July 30, 1933, to Esther Chaperon and Rodolfo Estripeaut in the Republic of Panama and later adopted by Glen Wesley Winberg of Fairhope, Alabama.

Aly graduated from Maria Imaculada Catholic Academy and accepted her first job with Aerovia Panama Airways as a stewardess. She was a trailblazer as the first native Panamanian female stewardess hired by the airline. She met the love of her life, Frederick (Freddy) Hill, on a flight from Miami to Panama. They were married at the Balboa Union church in the Canal Zone in Panama on October 17, 1959. Later their family would grow to include a daughter Kerrie Jan Smith (Hill) and a son Glenn Hill. They made their home in Diablo Heights, Canal Zone until Fred retired. They settled at Lake Forest in Daphne, Alabama June, 1980.

Aly was a wonderful daughter, sister to an identical twin and 5 other siblings, wife, mother and grandmother. Her greatest joy was spending time with her

children and granddaughter. She was loved by her family, friends, colleagues and neighbors. After the untimely death of her husband on June 10, 1985, she immediately transitioned from housewife to working mother and worked for over 30 years as a Customer Service Rep and a child care director. She was well known throughout the community and was recognized everywhere she went by past students and their parents, even after she retired.

She was preceded in death by her parents Esther and Glen Winberg, her husband Freddy Hill, her twin sister Odie Winberg Soper, her brother Rolando Winberg and her sister Debbie Winberg Fleming. She is survived by her sister Mildred Winberg Quinley, brother Glenn Wesley Winberg Jr., and brother Lawrence Ernest Winberg.

She was kind, generous and never met a stranger. Every day was a beautiful day and a new beginning.

However heartbroken we are, we choose to focus on her wonderful life. She was a sincere friend to many, a loving daughter, wife, parent, grandparent and she was a favorite Tia to many nieces and nephews.
