Betty Wallace Pickron, age 80, passed peacefully on March 6, 2026 in Hoover, Alabama surrounded by the love of her family. Betty was born in 1945 in Foley, Alabama, to Samuel Wallace and Emma Callaway Wallace. Betty was widely respected in her community as the original school secretary at Gulf Shores Elementary School, where she became a familiar and trusted presence to

generations of students, teachers, and parents. Her warmth, organization, and steady spirit made her beloved by all who knew her.

A dedicated and determined mother, Betty worked tirelessly to provide for her two sons and ensure they had every opportunity to succeed. Through sacrifice, faith, and perseverance, she created a loving home and a strong foundation for her family.

Betty also had a spirit of adventure and curiosity about the world. She was an avid traveler who visited all 50 states and numerous countries, embracing the opportunity to experience new places and cultures throughout her life.

Betty's greatest joy in life was her family, especially her beloved granddaughter Allie, who brought her tremendous pride and happiness. The faith she lived by and the values she instilled in her family will continue to guide those who loved her for generations to come.
