Bradley John Lafleur, 34, of Scott, Louisiana died Saturday, August 4, 2018 in Foley, Alabama, as a result of an aviation accident.

He was a 2002 graduate of Acadiana High School, where he shared some of his best memories on the drumline with fellow bandmates.

He is survived by the love of his life, Amanda, who was his wife of nine years and their three-year-old daughter, Piper, who he cherished more than life itself. He was also survived by his parents Judy and Chris, his sister, Amy and his in-laws, Missy and Greg Duplechain.

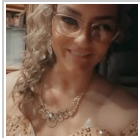

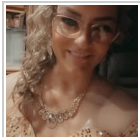
