Chris John Anderson Sr., a native of Staten Island, New York and a resident of Summerdale, Alabama, passed away at home on Wednesday, March 6, 2024. He was 75. Chris was a U.S. Army veteran, serving from 1968 to 1970.

Chris was born on Saturday, February 5, 1949 to Russell and Marguerite (née McCarthy) Anderson at the Staten Island Hospital. He will always be remembered for his genuine spirit and sarcastic wit.
