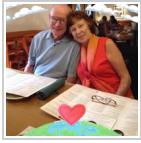

Chris will be greatly missed.

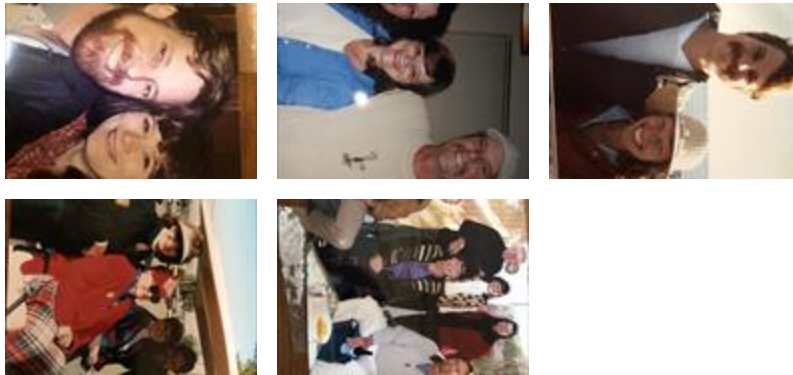

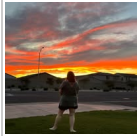

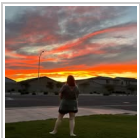
