Cynthia Edde Humphries, 69, a resident of Foley, Alabama passed away on Thursday, January 27, 2022. She was born on June 26, 1952 in Fort Benning, Georgia while her father was serving in the Army. As a child she grew up in Harriman and Rutledge, Tennessee, where her parents operated a Chevrolet dealership. Even as a child and teenager she had a larger-than-life and engaging spirit. She was dearly devoted to her family.

Cynthia loved serving Christ by ministering to others through her work, her cooking, and with her engaging personality. donated handmade quilts to individuals with long-term illnesses. But her most rewarding work came from ministering to families who had lost loved ones and spending time with and helping elderly and those in need. She faithfully served others until the day she passed.
