Formerly of Vernon, AL, Mr. Wallace was known for his work with the local Boy Scout Troop beginning in 1987 and ending in 1995.

While working at WWSA, he was known to be the radio voice of the Bulldogs at George Bell stadium.

He is preceded by his parents, William V. Wallace and Carolyn Wallace of Arvada, CO. Mr. Wallace is survived by his wife Judy Wallace, His two sons and their wives Toby and Karen Wallace of Gulf Shores, Jason and Debra Wallace of Vernon and his 3 grandchildren, Kasi Wallace of Gulf Shores, Zackary Wallace of Atlanta, GA and Levi Wallace of Gulf Shores along with one great grandson, Brentley Wallace, born to Levi Wallace. 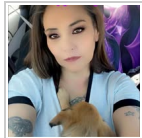
