In 1970 Dixie married Kenneth C. White. In the mid 70's Dixie sold the Burger Hut after which time she went on to manage the Great Day in Robertsdale. In 1980 Dixie became the Administrative assistant to the chef at the Marriott Grand Hotel in Point Clear, AL. After 23 years she retired

with many awards of recognition and appreciation. Dixie loved to travel, photography, crafts and genealogy.

Dixie is survived by her brother "Peco" Creighton C. Forsman and his wife Irene, 5 children; Diana Dickinson Hasna, James O. Dickinson Jr., Steven 'Craig' Dickinson, Edward 'Brent' Dickinson and Jennifer White Veins, 18 grandchildren and 17 great
