



Mrs Elsie Elizabeth Zywicki

Elsie McKenzie Zywicki, 78, a native and resident of Baldwin County, went to be with the Lord early on Friday morning, April 7, after a brief illness. She was at home and surrounded by family. Elsie was born to Raleigh & Maude McKenzie, the eldest of three children, and spent her childhood on the banks of Fish River where her father operated a ferry. She attended and graduated from Foley High School, and shortly thereafter, married the love of her life, Lee Zywicki, a handsome sailor that caught her eye when he was stationed at Barin Field. The young couple spent their first few years in Hawaii, where their oldest daughter Pam was born. When Lee left the Navy, they returned to Baldwin County and were blessed with two more daughters, Sandra and Dana. Eventually, the Zywicki family returned to the banks of Fish River, close to Elsie's beloved mother, whom she cared for until her death in 2004. In addition to working for the Monsanto Company, she spent many hours as a volunteer with the Foley High School Band, and was an avid gardener, cook, and collector. She enjoyed travel, and was a true fan of the University of Alabama football. Her greatest joy came from taking care of, and spending time with, her husband, children and grandchildren.

Elsie was preceded in death by her parents, her brother, Phil McKenzie, and her son-in-law, Steve Tapia, all of whom she looked forward to seeing in the days proceeding her death. She is survived by her husband of 60 years, Lee Zywicki, three daughters, Pam Engel (Larry), Sandra Morris (Keith), and Dana
