Harris Carl “Sonny” Grant, Jr. died on or about September 19, 2020, in his Loxley home.

Sonny Grant, born on September 9, 1955, in Mobile, Alabama to Harris Carl Grant, Sr. and Charlotte (Davis) Grant.

He grew up in Silverhill, Alabama. He attended Robertsdale High School and continued his education at Mobile College.
