Jack Edward Sutherland, 84, of Orange Beach, AL died January 9, 2020. He was born in Vancouver, Canada in 1935.

He served in the Canadian Navy and began his career with McDonald's Corporation in Canada later transferring to the United States where he rose to the position of Regional Vice President. After 25 years with the corporation, he became a McDonald's Owner/Operator with several restaurants in Slidell, LA. He retired to Orange Beach, AL in 2001.

Jack became a proud United States citizen in 1985, and was an avid supporter of the US military and America's veterans. He became a volunteer at the Pensacola Naval Air Station Museum restoring airplanes for exhibition and delighted in showing off "his" engines.
