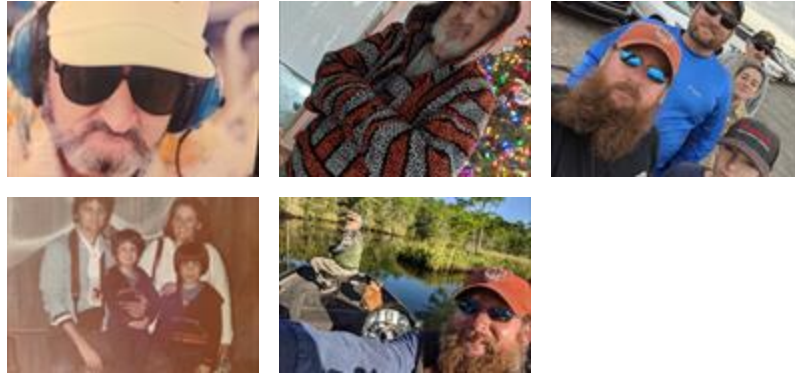
Julius Winston Kelly Jr. (Winston), a devoted father, grandfather, and native of Pensacola, Florida passed away peacefully on Thursday, November 6, 2025, at his home in Seminole, Alabama, at the age of 80. He was born on September 9, 1945, in Pensacola Florida to the late Julius Winston Kelly and Juanita Kelly. Winston dedicated 39 years of his professional life to the phone company, BellSouth, retiring after nearly four decades of service. Beyond his career, Winston was a man of deep community commitment, notably serving for many years as a volunteer firefighter. He was a highly respected member of the Masonic fraternity, achieving the distinction of Master Mason and serving as a Shriner. A true outdoorsman and sports enthusiast, Winston had a lifelong passion for fly fishing and hunting. He was an exceptional sportsman on the course, recognized as a scratch golfer. His lover for speed was evident in his enjoyment of dirt track and NASCAR racing, a passion that started in his youth when he raced go-karts and volunteered to help with race cars at Five Flags Speedway. Winston was a devoted student of history, especially World War II. He was a frequent visitor to the air museum at Naval Air Station Pensacola and cherished the annual tradition of attending the Blue Angels Homecoming air show with his family. His unique personality was defined by his playful spirit; as his family fondly remembers, "If Dad didn't like you, he wouldn't pick on you." He was preceded in death by his parents Julius Winston Kelly Sr. and Juanita Kelly, and his sisters Rosalie Nock and Glenda Murray. Winstons memory will be cherished by his two loving sons, Glenn
