LLOYD MILTON LOGAN

A long-time resident of Mobile and native of Arkansas, Captain Lloyd M. Logan, U. S. Coast Guard Retired, crossed the bar on May 14th, 2016. He was born in North Little Rock, lived in Atlanta, Miami, Memphis, and Brinkley, Arkansas during his early years. A graduate of Miami Senior High School, he was employed by the U. S. Post Office until he enlisted in the Coast Guard prior to Pearl Harbor. His assignments during his thirty years of service to our country, included the Reserve Officers Training School, New London, the Armed Forces Staff College, Third, Seventh, Eighth, and Twelfth Coast Guard Districts, nine ships, three of which he commanded. His final duty was Commanding Officer, U. S. Coast Guard Cutter MORGENTHAU (WHEC722) deployed to Vietnam, for which service he was awarded two Bronze Stars with Combat V, and the Navy Commendation Medal by the Secretary of the Navy. The cutter and crew earned a Navy Unit Citation. Captain Logan is a graduate of the University of South Alabama, a member of Spring Hill Baptist Church, Loop Lodge No. 895, F & AM, and other service organizations.

His parents and his wife, Rena Katherine Hunt, preceded him in death. Son, Richard (Teresa), four grandchildren, Katherine, Michael, Brad, Matthew and a great-grandson, Joey, survive him.

A memorial service will be held on June 18th at 2pm at the Spring Hill Baptist

Church Chapel, 2 South McGregor Ave., Mobile, AL 36608, with visitation beginning at 1pm. As per his wishes, Captain Logan's ashes will be scattered in the Gulf of Mexico in a private ceremony.
