Mike was the type of man who never met a stranger. He would immediately embrace you and make you feel like family. Regardless of the situation, he would give everything he had to anyone in need. Mike had a great sense of humor and found it amusing to introduce himself "Michael Jackson," often adding he was the white Michael Jackson and would attempt the moonwalk to add to the fun. He enjoyed playing shuffleboard, spending time with friends and family, and living life on his own terms. Seeing smiles on others' faces brought him great joy. In recent years, he found fulfillment in sharing his personal story of survival, his faith in Jesus, and the obstacles he overcame. He took pride in being punctual, always early for everything!

Michael graduated from Westside High School in Memphis, TN, in 1982. He immediately entered the workforce, primarily working as an account manager/salesperson. He eventually retired from NCI Building Systems, Inc. He always took great pride in his work, no matter the task or job!

Mr. Jackson was preceded in death by his father, Alvis Lee "Bubba" Jackson;

step-father Ronnie Hughey; son-in-law, Patrick Brown; and brother-in-law, Chad Cleary.
