On Thursday, December 17, 2020 Myrna L. (Clarke) Fabiano loving wife and mother passed away at age 81 in Foley, Alabama, formerly of Union City, Michigan.

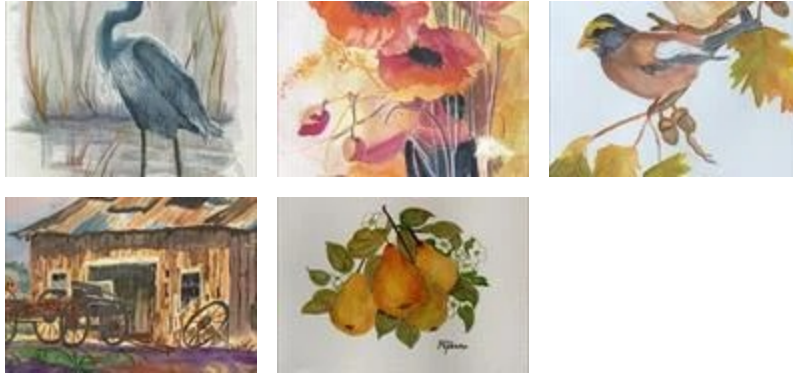
