The memorial service for Norman Lademan will be held on Friday February 8th, 2019 with visitation from 10 – 12pm at the American Legion Post #6 in Corinth, MS with Brother Keith Holloway officiating. Burial to follow in the Corinth National Cemetery with full military honors. Norman Lademan "Papa" was born June 12, 1940 to Leonard and Michaeline Lademan in Detroit, MI. Norman attended and graduated Detroit Jesuit High School and Academy. During high school he was on the track team and football team. Following graduation, he enlisted in the Marine Corp and served in the Vietnam Conflict. He was given an honorable discharge with the rank of Corporal. After leaving the Marines, he began his truck driving career in California. He later moved back to Detroit where he drove for Grand Packing Company. He met and married Marcy Pannell and moved to Marcy's hometown of Tishomingo, MS. In Tishomingo he drove for Bingham Systems and achieved 1,000,000 accident free miles in 1982. In 1985, he began driving for Perfect Cut Manufacturing, Inc. and achieved 2,000,000 accident free miles for them. Norman, although on the road a great deal was able to maintain a good family relationship with his children. He was a former commander of the American Legion Post # 6 in Corinth, MS, a member of The Patriot Guard and a member of the Marine Corp League. He was voted Marine of The Year by the Marine Corp League in 2014. He enjoyed going to the American Legion and participating in Stew Day, VFW, 40/8 Association, the beach, his family and anything having to do with the Marine Corp. He is survived by his sister

Marlene Lademan Strahan, children Leigh Turner and husband Reggie, Terry Kettler and wife Sandra & Lisa Kemp, 11 Grandchildren, 11 Great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews, and special friend of 51 years Ima Jean Smith. 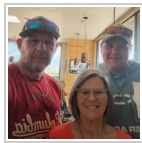
