Patsy Harrison Carleton, 75, of Orange Beach, AL, died May 21, 2023, of complications from surgery at Thomas Hospital in Fairhope. She is survived by her husband of 39 years, George, her daughter Casey Bowman, son-in-law Jason Bowman, a grandson, Wyatt Bowman, a granddaughter, Brenna Bowman and two sisters, Joann Thomas of Arlington, VA, and Peggy Long of Palmetto, FL.
