Paul Denis Berube, 72, of Foley, Alabama, passed away on Saturday, May 25, 2024, from complications of heart disease.

Born May 5, 1952, in Fall River, Massachusetts, he was raised in nearby Somerset by his late parents Louis and Lorraine Berube. Over the years, Paul worked as a sales manager for several glassware manufacturers and car dealerships in Southeastern Massachusetts and Rhode Island. He proudly served nine years in the 1-211th Field Artillery Battalion of the Army National Guard from 1971 to 1980. Later in life, he returned to service as a volunteer firefighter in Meredith and Center Harbor, New Hampshire.

Paul had a lifelong love of cars. He enjoyed attending NASCAR races and taking long drives, which translated into an enjoyable post-retirement career with Uber. Paul was also an avid reader and prolific writer, self-publishing a series of poetry books about American folklore and life lessons.
