Priscilla Fuller, age 76, of Gulf Shores, Alabama, passed away peacefully at home on Tuesday, January 19th 2016.

Priscilla was born May 1st, 1939 in Paterson, N.J. to Irving and Shirley (Dumnick) Morris. After earning her associate degree from Fairleigh-Dickenson University, she worked as a press reporter for a newspaper in Rochester, NY where she developed her lifelong love of words.

In 1971, she married Kenneth (Ken) Craig Fuller, Sr, in Poughkeepsie, NY, and the two combined families from previous marriages. They soon thereafter opened a culinary retail store they named Gourmet Compliments, which was frequented by the staff and students of the Culinary Institute of America in Rhinebeck, N.Y, for which Priscilla served as the Vice President of the Wine and Food Society. Following her husband's work transfer to Atlanta, GA in 1977, she continued to share her expertise in the culinary retail business as manager and buyer for DinnerWarehouse, until retiring and moving to Gulf Shores in the early 1990s.

Outside of work, for many years, one could find Priscilla on the tennis courts with friends most weekends, performing her wicked return-of-serve backhand.

Until his death in 2004, Ken collaborated with Priscilla in investment real

estate focused on beach condominiums. During this time, Priscilla was able to apply her creative energies to her love of decorating and design of these condominiums and of their personally built homes.

She is survived by her son Marc (Lindauer) Austin and daughter Julie (Lindauer) Jacobson from her first marriage to Frank Lindauer, step-daughter Diane Fuller, step-son Kenneth Craig Fuller, Jr., his wife Anne and their two children James & Kristen, grandson Michael, granddaughter Ally, step-granddaughter Candice, step-grandson Jonathan, great-granddaughter Aubree, and niece Jenny Morris.

Per her wishes, a portion of her ashes will be buried next to her late husband at the Elberta Public Cemetery; the remaining ashes will be scattered along Romar Beach, near the site of their former home.

In honor of Priscilla's love of "all creatures great and small" (especially her four-legged "children"), memorial donations may be made to the ASPCA, the Alabama Gulf Coast Zoo, the Friends of Bon Secour National Wildlife Refuge, or to an animal charitable organization of ones choosing.

She is survived in death by her daughter, Julie, her step-daughter, Diane, her son, Marc, her step-son, Kenneth Craig, Jr., her grand-daughter, Ally, her grandson, Michael, her step-grand-daughter, Kristen, her step-granddaughter, Candice, her step-grandson, Jonathan, her step-grandson, James, and her great-grand-daughter, Aubree.

As was her creative want, half of her ashes will be scattered along the Gulf Coast; the remaining half will be buried next to her deceased husband, Kenneth Craig Fuller, Sr.

Priscilla was born to Irving and Shirley Morris in Paterson, N.J. on May 1st, 1939. She went on to college where she majored in Journalism. After a brief stint as a press reporter, she met her first husband-to-be, Frank Lindauer, and the two were married in 1961. Two children, Marc, and Julie, were born from this marriage. After ten (10) years together, Priscilla met IBM corporate pilot Kenneth Fuller in Poughkeepsie, N.Y. with children of his own. The two fell in love instantly and married in August, 1971. Shortly thereafter, Priscilla and Ken opened Gourmet Compliments, a gourmet cooking shop for and largely by Priscilla. In 1977, her husband was transferred to Atlanta, Georgia. Priscilla, along with a friend and business partner, opened a similar gourmet shop, DinnerWarehouse, in Marietta, Georgia. During this time, she also experimented quite successfully as a sales rep for TransArt, a company specializing in decorating homes with upscale artwork.

In 1984, her husband, Ken, opted for early retirement. Relocating to Orange Beach, AL., they decided to settle directly on the beach. With their children grown, the two embarked upon a journey that would last nearly ten (10) years, creating a very successful condominium real estate stretch along the east and west side of Orange Beach. Her greatest and most fulfilling accomplishment was

creating and decorating each and every condominium unit owned by the Fullers for the world to enjoy. Both spared little expense as their guest books would attest to, these were among the finest condos ever visited by those lucky enough to experience such a joyful oceanfront atmosphere. During this time, she and her husband also dabbled in selling real estate as well, Priscilla eventually abandoning this initiative to continue to concentrate on her condominium aspirations.

In life, many great things come to an end, and Dad (Ken) passed away in late 2004.
