



Dr Roy Wilks Hammock

November 11, 1949 - January 13, 2017

Roy Wilks Hammock M.D., 67, of Fairhope, Ala., passed away on January 13, 2017, in Fairhope. His death followed a 12-year battle with Parkinson's disease. Hammock had served as an emergency physician in Birmingham and most recently, in Mobile at Providence Hospital.

Hammock was born at St. Vincent's Hospital in Birmingham, Alabama, on November 11, 1949, to the Rev. William Raymond Hammock Sr. and Mary Frances (Wilks) Hammock. He graduated from Central High School in Phenix City, Ala., in 1968, where he excelled in athletics, academics and leadership. During his senior year of high school, he served as governor of the Alabama district of Key Club International.

After graduating from Duke University with a degree in English and a love of Hemingway, he received his medical training at the University of South Alabama College of Medicine. A lifelong avid outdoorsman, Hammock could often be found in the woods and on the waters of south Alabama and the Gulf of Mexico. He passed along to his daughter and son a love of nature and the outdoors.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Mary Frances (Wilks) Hammock and father, William Raymond Hammock, Sr.

His survivors include a daughter, Virginia F. Hammock of Frisco, Colorado, and son, Roy Wilks Hammock Jr., of Perdido Key, Florida, and two brothers, Williams R. Hammock, Jr. of Fairhope and H. Rex Hammock of Nashville.

A memorial service will be held Monday, January 16 at 2 p.m. at Springhill Baptist Church in Mobile. Visitation will take place at 1 p.m., preceding the service.
