



## Talmadge "T.C." Rogers

July 30, 1934 - July 18, 2020

Talmadge Clarence "T.C." Rogers, 85, went to be with the Lord July 18, 2020 at West Florida Hospital, Pensacola, Florida. He was born to James Lovett and Martha Jane Parker Rogers on July 30, 1934 in Reidsville, Georgia.

When he was a young boy his father became ill and the family moved to the Pine Ridge, Louisiana, near Kentwood to be near his sister Verda. His father died when he was 15 years old.

T.C. got up at 3 a.m. every morning to help in his brother-in-law John's dairy until he graduated from Greensburg High School in 1955 and joined the U.S. Air Force as an aircraft mechanic. He enjoyed seeing the world, serving 3 years in Europe and 1 year in Vietnam. He was also stationed at Nellis AFB, near Las Vegas, Nevada; Travis AFB, Fairfield, California; and Craig AFB, Selma, Alabama. He retired as Technical Sergeant following his second tour at Craig in 1976.

T.C. married his wife of 58 years Myrtice Yvonne Allen Rogers in 1961. They moved near Yvonne's family and built a home in Gateswood, Alabama. He got a job at Dentalez in Bay Minette, AL and then went to work at NAS Pensacola using his aircraft mechanic skills until retiring in 1993. He enjoyed working in the garden, reading, listening to his extensive C.D. collection, cutting grass, taking great care of his vehicles and spending time with his grandson Marcus and his white German Shepard, Hunter.

He was a member of New Hope United Methodist Church for over 43 years where he served on various committees. He was also a member of NARFE


Chapter #1340 since retiring from NAS Pensacola.
