Teresa Jan Croxton

On June 18, 2018 Teresa Jan Croxton passed away at South Baldwin Regional Medical Center.

Teresa Jan Croxton, who went by “Jan” for most of her life, was born on July 16, 1951 in Linton, Indiana. She was born exactly two years after her older brother Tim Croxton and exactly thirty-one years before her nephew Greg Manger. She would often say that Greg was the best birthday present that she ever received.

Jan’s family later moved to Lafayette, Indiana where her father, William (Bill) Croxton ran a successful children’s dental practice. While growing up, she learned a lot about both business and dentistry while working in her father’s practice.

In 1969, Jan graduated from Jefferson High School in Lafayette, Indiana. After graduating from High School, she took some college courses at Indiana State University and Purdue University while working as a dental assistant.

In 1974, Jan met Phil Manger of Baltimore, Maryland in Chicago. Phil and Jan were married in Towson, Maryland in 1976. The marriage produced one son,

Stephen Manger, and they divorced in 1988. While her then-husband was teaching and pursuing his doctorate, Jan lived in Atlanta, Georgia and Berea, Kentucky, where she continued her education and began her career in information technology.

Phil and Jan moved to Maryland in 1983 where she continued her career in information technology. One of the highlights of her career was the early work that she did for the Maryland Infants and Toddlers program in the 1990's. The Maryland Infants and Toddlers program is a family-centered system of early intervention services for young children with developmental delays and disabilities—and their families. Jan was especially proud of the families that she helped through this program.

In 2004, Jan moved to Lillian, Alabama to assist her aging father and continue her career in information technology. She retired in 2014 and devoted more of her time to volunteering at St. Paul's Episcopal Church and most recently Kairos Prison Ministry.

Jan is preceded in death by her younger brother, Jon Croxton. She is survived by her son, Stephen Manger, her two older brothers Tim Croxton and Tom Croxton, her step-mother Polly Croxton, her step-sister Cindy Meinhardt, her three nieces Erika Croxton, Phoebe Croxton, and Kim Manger, her two nephews Christopher Croxton and Greg Manger, her step-niece Kelly Wood and three step-nephews Michael Wood, Trey Meinhardt, and Brandt Meinhardt.
