Theodore J. “Ted” McClain, 94, of Elberta, AL passed away at his home on the morning of March 16th, 2017. He was born in Lockhart, AL but spent most of his formative years growing up in Marianna, FL. As a young man and gifted woodworker, he was employed in construction, carpentry, cabinetmaking, hardwood floor refinishing and for a short time, co-owned a service station with one of his brothers. Like millions of his generation he enlisted for service in World War II. He served in the Army Air Corps as a gunnery instructor for B-17 flight crews. After discharge from the military he eventually took a civil service job in aircraft sheet metal fabrication and later as an instructor in that department. After a long career he retired from NAS Pensacola, FL as a Production Coordinator for aircraft rework.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Thomas Jefferson McClain and Bonnie Pate McClain, brothers, Celand McClain, Thomas “Tommy” McClain, Grady McClain, Eugene McClain and Glen McClain, sisters Christine M. Wilson and Thelma Mims and his son-in-law, Robert L. Harlan. He is survived by his loving wife of sixty-two years, Johnnie G. McClain, his sons, Mark W. McClain (Debra) and Greg A. McClain, and daughter Laura M. Harlan. Also surviving are brothers Bruce McClain (Ayako) of Tacoma, WA and Morgan McClain (Dorothy) of Jacksonville, FL and many nieces, nephews, family

members and friends.
