



## Mr Theron Rhett Mozingo Jr

Theron Rhett Mozingo, Jr. of Gulf Shores, Al passed away Tuesday June 6, 2017. Rhett was born December 28, 1930 in Waycross, Georgia. He was the son of the late Theron Rhett Mozingo, Sr and Mary Henry Etta Lanter Mozingo.

Rhett was raised in Montgomery, Al. He attended Sidney Lanier High School where he was a star baseball player. He was a graduate of Alabama Polytechnic Institute, (Auburn University) with a degree in Forestry. He was a Captain in the United States Army and served as an Artillery and hand to hand combat instructor during the time of the Korean Conflict. One of his biggest disappointments was not seeing action during the conflict.

Upon graduation and honorable discharge from the Army, Rhett begin a career working as a forester in the paper industry. From 1956 to 1974 he workEd for Container Cooperation of America's Mill in Brewton, Al. From 1974 until his retirement in 1994 he worked as the Wood Procurement Manager for Virginia Fibre Cooperation in Amherst, Va.

Once retired, he returned to the Gulf Coast Area having had enough of the sometimes harsh winters living in the foothills of the Blue Ridge mountains.

Rhett and his wife enjoyed not only traveling around the country but world

travel as well. They continued traveling until his health began to fail a few years ago.

Rhett is survived by his wife of 65 years, Joy Elliott Mozingo, his High School sweetheart, and 3 children, Debra M. Stuart (Bill) of Gulf Shores, Michael R. Mozingo, Sr (Deborah) of Amherst, Va and William Murray Mozingo (Monica) of Silverhill, Al, 6 grandchildren, 1 step grandchild, and 11 great grandchildren and 2 step great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by an infant child, Donna Anne Mozingo.

There will be a Celebration of Life Memorial Service held on Saturday June 10th at 11:00 at the Oyster Bay Baptist Church in Gulf Shores.
