Thomas Walker Alison of Foley, Alabama, passed away on Saturday, November 11 of Covid related complications. Thomas was born on November 26, 1927 in Vick, Arkansas to Stephen Lee and Lula Mae Alison. He is survived by his wife of 70 years, Gail Irene Alison; his son, Daniel Lee Alison and daughter Wendy Alison all of Foley, Alabama. He was preceded in death by his sister Irene East and brothers Stephen Lee Alison and Billy Alison all of Little Rock, Arkansas, his sisters Nancy Gerber of Oklahoma City and Doris Pittman of Pryor, Oklahoma, grandson Thomas Gordon Alison, granddaughter Ann-Marie Alison and great-son, Jackson Thomas Emerson of Mobile, Alabama. After graduating highschool in 1945, Tom was drafted in the Army in September of 1946 and was honorably discharged as a staff Sargent in January of 1948. The G.I. bill enabled Tom to enroll at Louisiana State University in 1949 as a Forestry major where he graduated Magna cum laud. After graduation, Tom was employed by Buckeye Cellulose of Perry, Florida where he retired in 1978 after 26 years as a Forester. Shortly after his retirement, Tom and his wife Gail bought an R.V. and spent the

next 35 years working for the National Park Service in Yellowstone National Park before retiring in 2013. Graveside services will be held at Spanish Fort Veterans cemetery at Spanish Fort, Alabama when Gail is able to attend.
