We have learned recently of the May 12 passing of Thomas “Tod” Seel, in Savannah, Georgia. Tod and his wife of fifty years, Megan, had moved to Savannah in 2016, leaving the waters Tod fished and waded and their beloved home in Moran, Wyoming, near Jackson Hole. Tod started Dartmouth with the class of 1965. Classmate Gary Herbst reports that he probably left Dartmouth after his second year—he’s shown as a sophomore in a Bones Gate picture with Herbst—but later returned and graduated both undergrad and Tuck (1969). Megan wishes Tod to be remembered by the e. e. cummings poem “up into the silence the green,” which so eloquently expresses their love for each other and their days in Moran.
