Celebrating the Life of Twynette Thompson Wigfield

October 30, 1931 – April 22, 2026

Twynette Thompson Wigfield, age 94, entered the presence of Jesus on April 22, 2026, peacefully in her home with family by her side.

A woman of deep faith, enduring love, and quiet strength, Twynette leaves behind a legacy that spans five generations. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband of 47 years, Elvin Thompson; her husband of 17 years, Roy Dallas Wigfield; her father, Clayton Harris; her mother, Virgie Mae Jenkins; and her stepfather, Harold Jenkins, siblings: Carolyn Jones, Barbara Denty, Jean Justice and Johnny Jenkins.

She is survived by her children, Janice Thompson Hicks and her husband Don, and Marcus Elvin Thompson and his wife Susan Nowling Thompson; her siblings, Betty Breedlove and Robert Harris; and her grandchildren, Jeremy Sullivan and his wife Angie, Kevin Sullivan and his wife Sunnie, Brandon Thompson, Scott Thompson and his wife Jennie, and Justin Thompson. She also dearly loved her bonus grandchildren, Stacey Hardin and her husband Jamie, and Amanda Griggs, as her own. Twynette retired in 1985 as Personnel Manager of Sears in Pensacola. She also co-owned Thompson Meat Supply in Pensacola, Florida, a thriving family business established in 1967 with her husband Elvin, his brother Selmer, and Selmer's wife Jean.

After retirement, Twynette enjoyed years of RV travel with Elvin until his passing in 1995. She later moved to their bay house in Josephine, Alabama. After five years of widowhood, she met Roy Dallas Wigfield at church, and they married in 2000, sharing 17 wonderful years together until his passing in 2017.

Twynette was a founding board member of Christians United Ministries, Inc., where her faith and service helped shape a ministry that continues to touch countless lives.

In 2019, she was diagnosed with Alzheimer's Dementia and required full-time care during the final years of her life. Even then, she remained grateful, loving, compassionate, and servant-hearted. She gave joy freely, laughed often, and thanked God daily.

More than anything, Twynette was known for her unwavering faith and her deep love for family. She had a beautiful gift for making others feel seen, valued, and deeply loved. In her final moments, her favorite hymns, "Amazing Grace" and "Blessed Assurance," were sung over her by those who loved her.
