Sergeant Walter Mack Yohn Sr., age 85, of Foley, Alabama went to dance with the angels on Thursday, December 27, 2018. Sergeant Yohn is preceded in death by his wife, Carolyn A. Yohn, and his parents, R. C. and Mildred Yohn, of Fairhope, Alabama. Sergeant Yohn served his community for many years. After receiving an Honorable Discharge from the Army, he began his long term career as a Law Enforcement Officer. He began at Fairhope Police Department in the late 1950s and retired from Gulf Shores Police Department in 2008 at the age of

75. While policing, he also served as a volunteer Fire Fighter for Fairhope Fire Department and had the opportunity to ride on some of the first Ambulances in Baldwin County. During his career at Gulf Shores Police Department, he also worked as a Park Ranger for the Alabama Gulf State Park. He finally laid down his duty weapon and officially retired from the Alabama Gulf State Park at the age of 78. Sergeant Yohn received numerous awards and recognitions during his career, including a Flag Pole dedicated in his honor that stands at The Gulf Shores Police Department. He created the D.A.R.E program in local schools to teach young children about Drug Awareness and was a member and held many duties with the Fraternal Order of Police Pleasure Isle Lodge 60.

A celebration of life will be held to honor Sergeant Walter Mack Yohn Sr. on Saturday, January 12, 2019 at 1100hrs. The ceremony will be held at the United Methodist Church Auditorium in Gulf Shores, Alabama (1720 Gulf Shores Parkway, Gulf Shores, Alabama 36542).
